Class conditions to be conducted and scored under Table II.2a. Timed first jump off. Each competitor will jump one round over a course of at least 10 fences. After the first round, in the event of equality of faults for first place only, there will be one jump-off in which time will decide. The remaining competitors will be classified according to their faults only in the first round. In ties for other than first place, the prize money will be added together and divided equally: riders to draw for ribbons. Eligibility: To be eligible a horse must have entered and shown in at least one Jumper class.

Please get your entries in early to avoid disappointment.

### ***Entries***

In order for stalls to be held, full payment must follow stall reservations. No stabling reservations will be held without payment. Visa and MasterCard will be accepted. Stalls will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. (By the date the check is received or the post mark on the envelope.)

Numbers will not be issued without a SIGNED OPEN CHECK logged with the horse show secretary.

The entry form must include:

- All classes or divisions entered
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibiting.
- Organization membership numbers.
- Social Security or Federal ID number of owner.

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Sanctioning Assoc., will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

### ***Stabling***

Three hundred five (305) stalls with doors are available. Contact Pam Minnick at (828) 272-0735. Initial bedding will not be provided.

### ***Damage***

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly. (This includes screw eyes or nails in stalls.)

### ***Lunging***

No lunging permitted in the show rings or schooling areas. Lunging only in designated areas.

### ***Schooling***

Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times. \$100 fine for anyone caught in the rings before or after the show if rings have been closed. Some rings will be available for schooling after the show day. Closing times will be announced each day. The rings will be available in the morning until 30 minutes before start time. Management may restrict schooling in any ring if conditions warrant.

### ***Day Exhibitors/Non-Stabling***

Horses entered but not stabled must use the designated area for day exhibitors. \$25 grounds fee per horse per show day, and a \$20 service fee per horse.

### ***Feed & Bedding***

Bedding reservations are available through the horse show office. Deliveries, other than those made through the horse show office, are not permitted. No Saturday deliveries.

### ***Attire***

Jackets will be worn for the hunter and equitation classes in the show rings. Riders will be allowed to show in tucked in polo shirts in the jumper rings. The classics and mini-prix require formal attire.

### ***Non-Showing Horse***

Horses or ponies not showing will be charged \$35 per show day fee and a \$20 service fee.

### ***Non-Negotiable Checks***

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$30 or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashiers check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

### ***Food***

Food service will be available on the grounds beginning the day of the show through Sunday.

### ***Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts***

Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles, ATV's, motorcycles, golf carts, etc. on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show.

**Motor Homes**

Motor home and camper hook-ups are available. Camper spaces are available for \$35/night.

**Parking**

Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and campers, from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or unload. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

**Protective Headgear**

All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitted protective headgear on the show grounds when mounted. Additionally, all juniors must wear ASTM approved protective headgear with harness secured and properly fitted while riding in the designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds. The sanctioning association encourages all riders to wear protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the show grounds. It is the responsibility of the rider, parents, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

**Minor Exhibitors**

Parent(s) or guardian(s) of a minor child shall hold the horse show management and the facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted, or number issued unless a parent or legal guardian signs the entry. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted.

**Dogs**

All dogs must be under control at all times while on the show grounds. Unrestrained dogs create a serious safety hazard for exhibitors and their horses. Loose dogs will not be tolerated in the show ring area. They will be impounded and the owner will be charged a \$100 fine added to their entry fee, which will be donated to the Foothills Humane Society.

**Prize Money**

The owner of any horse/pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded MUST provide a Social Security number or Federal ID number on the entry. Prize money checks will be mailed within 30 days after the show. If there are not five or more in an add back class, the entry fee drops to \$20 with nothing added back.

**Add/Scratch**

No slip, no trip. If you are not on the class sheet, you must add in the show office and bring the slip to the in-gate. If you are scratching, you must also do this in the show office and bring your slip to the in-gate.

### **Palmetto Medal Class**

Open to Junior riders who are members of the SCHJA. Horses to jump 3', ponies to jump 2'6" over a modified hunter course. Only one rider per horse or pony, to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse or pony. Three (3) riders needed to fill the class. (One fourth of the exhibitors, or no less than 2 exhibitors, must return for flat work.) The flat work shall count 25%. Points will be cumulative, with the top 20 riders including ties being eligible for the finals.

### **SCHJA Governor's Equitation Class**

Open to Junior members of the SCHJA and may be ridden on a horse or pony. Only one rider per horse or pony. To be shown over a modified hunter course of 8 fences with fences set at 3'. The course must include a combination which counts as one fence, at least two changes of direction, and two spread fences. There must be five exhibitors to fill the class. Four or more riders must return for additional flat work at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. The under saddle performance shall count 25%.

### **NCHJA Children's Equitation Class**

Open to Junior members of the NCHJA. Must be a member before entering the Class. To be shown over a hunter type course of not less than eight fences 2'9" in height and one-third of the obstacles must be oxers. Only one rider per horse. Four competitors to fill the class. Three competitors must complete the course. Judges may ask contestants to perform USEF tests 1-19. The NCHJA Children's Equitation Class may be combined with the NCHJA Adult Equitation Class if there are less than 4 entries. NCHJA Adult Equitation Class Open to Amateur Senior members of the NCHJA. Must be a member before entering the Class. To be shown over a hunter type course of not less than eight fences 2'9" in height and one-third of the obstacles must be oxers. Only one rider per horse. Four competitors to fill the class. Three competitors must complete the course. Judges may ask contestants to perform USEF tests 1-19. The NCHJA Adult Equitation Class may be combined with the NCHJA Children's Equitation Class if there are less than 4 entries. NCHJA Pony Equitation Class Open to Junior members of the NCHJA. Must be a member before entering the Class. To be shown over a hunter type course of not less than eight fences with no combinations and one-third of the obstacles must be oxers. Small/Medium Ponies jump 2'3"; Large Ponies jump 2'9". Only one rider per pony. Four competitors to fill the class. Three competitors must complete the course. Judges may ask contestants to perform USEF tests 1-9.

### **BRHJA Medal Class**

Open to all BRHJA Junior members. Fences are to be set at 2'6" for ponies and riders 13 years and under. Fences for horses and riders 14-17 years shall be set at 3'. The top six (6) riders over fences shall return to be judged on the flat. Jumping portion shall count 70%, flat portion to count 30%.

### ***Rules and Exhibitor Information***

- 1) All hunter classes count toward year-end totals for BRHJA, NCHJA and SCHJA members whose dues have been paid prior to showing.
- 2) Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes and points as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1½. Championship (10 points) and Reserve (6 points) ribbons may be awarded in each division, including Equitation, with more than four horses. Hack points are added to the top four horses over fences.
- 3) According to BRHJA, NCHJA and SCHJA rules all classes must have at least three entries for points to be awarded.
- 4) Adult riders do not have to own their horses, but they must be amateurs.
- 5) **Short Stirrup** riders aged 14 and under are those in their first or second year of showing and may cross enter into their age group Equitation. **Long Stirrup** riders 14 & over in first or second year of showing, may cross enter in age group equitation.
- 6) **First Year Green** is for horses not shown over 2'9" prior to the start of the current show year. **Second Year Green** is for horses in their second year of showing over 2'9" or higher.
- 7) **Low Hunter** is open to all horses and ponies.
- 8) Ponies must not exceed 14.2 and must be ridden by a junior.
- 9) **Junior Amateur** will not be split with fewer than three in each section.
- 10) **Pre-Green Hunter**: Open to horses or ponies not shown over fences at any show prior to the start of the current show year.
- 11) **Regular Working Hunter**: Open to all horses with no restrictions on previous showing.
- 12) **Children's Hunter**: Open to all horses ridden by a junior exhibitor. Horse and rider combination may not cross enter into the Junior Hunter division. Management may combine this division with the Adult Amateur division if there are fewer than six entries in each division.
- 16) **Hopeful**: Open to all horses and ponies regardless of winnings. Fence height 2'6".
- 17) **Child/Adult Amateur Jumper**: Open to all horses ridden by either a junior or an adult. Amateur must meet amateur status requirements. Horse and rider combination may not cross enter into the Junior/Amateur Jumper division. Fence height 3'3"-3'6".
- 18) **Low and High Schooling Jumper**: Open to any horse regardless of winnings. Low fence height 3'-3'3". High fence height 3'6"-3'9".
- 19) **Junior Amateur Jumper**: Open to all horses ridden by either a junior or amateur exhibitor. Horse and rider combination may not cross enter into the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper division in same show. Level 5
- 20) **Open Jumper**: Open to all horses. May not cross enter into the Low Training Jumper at the same show. Level 5
- 21) **Special Hunter**: 2'3" & 2'6": Open to all horses and ponies no restriction on the rider.
- 22) **Low Hunter 2'6" or 3'**: Open to all horses and ponies no restriction on the rider.

23) Classes will be judged on soundness, pace, manners, way of going, and jumping styles. Suitability will be emphasized in Short Stirrup and Children's Hunter.

24) Classes may be combined, split, or canceled at the discretion of the show management.

25) Owners and exhibitors are responsible for all horses and fees entered by them or their agents, even though payment of these fees are not submitted along with entry blanks.

26) FENCE, BRHJA, and SCHJA, NCHJA will not be responsible for injury to horses or riders or any individual, nor will they be responsible for the loss of personal property.

27) All dogs must be on leashes at all times. Owners of unleashed dogs may be fined for the removal of the dog.

28) **Walk-Trot:** Showing at the walk and trot by junior exhibitors that have never cantered at any horse show. Three classes are to be offered. The first class to be judged as a pleasure class, the second on equitation and the third under saddle.

29) **Walk-Trot-Canter:** Showing at the walk, trot, and canter by junior exhibitors. Three classes are to be offered. The first class to be judged as a pleasure class, the second on equitation and the third under saddle.

30) **Crossrails:** Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior or adult amateur exhibitor. To be shown over a simplified course of four to eight crossrail jumps. Riders may not cross enter into any classes that have a greater fence height than 18". The three-inch rule does not apply.

31) **Mini-Prix Class Check In.** Saturday at 3:00pm. All exhibitors entering the Mini Prix must check in and the horse is not allowed to leave show grounds after check in. Course will be set at level 5.

32) **Child/Adult Amateurs (horse/rider combination):** that competes at this show at or over level 4 can not compete in Junior amateur classes.

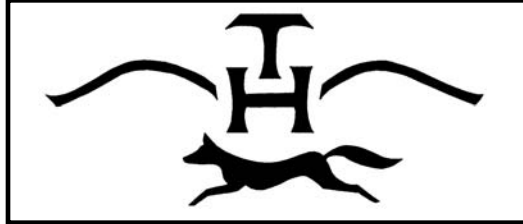
#### Directions to FENCE:

**From I-26, east or west:** Take S.C. Exit #1 from I-26, toward Landrum, S.C. Go 1.5 miles, and then turn right onto Bomar Road (look for the Land Mart on the corner). Go one short block and turn right onto Prince Road. After 1.7 miles, turn left onto Hunting Country Road, just before the I-26 Bridge. Go .5 mile to the FENCE Equestrian entrance on the left.

**From Greenville or Greer on Highway 14:** Cross the railroad tracks in downtown Landrum, S.C. After passing the First Baptist Church on your right, look for the Post Office. Bear left just after the Post Office onto Prince Road. At 1.7 miles, turn left onto Hunting Country Road. Go 1.2 miles to FENCE Equestrian entrance on your left.

**From Tryon on Route 176:** Travel south on 176 to the South Carolina state line. Bear left onto Ridge Road (at Mimosa Carpet on your left). Cross railroad tracks and bear left onto Hunting Country Road. Continue 3.6 miles to the FENCE Equestrian entrance on your right.

**From Columbus on Highway 108:** Go south on Walker Street from downtown Columbus. Travel two blocks to four-way stop and turn right onto Peniel Road. Stay on Peniel Road past Tryon Estates and Morgan Chapel Village, then bear right at fork onto Golden Road. Continue 1.6 miles to stop sign at River Road, which is unpaved. Turn right, then immediately left over a steel bridge onto Morgan Chapel Road. Follow Morgan Chapel Road .7 miles to end, then turn left onto Hunting Country Road. Continue .7 miles to FENCE Equestrian entrance on your right.
